Volunteers

Over 2,000 hours were spent by volunteers attending committee meetings, running the Carriage House Gift Shop at Rose Hill, transcribing diaries and oral histories, tending the garden at the Geneva History Museum, and helping with the *Holiday Market* and other projects. In 2021, **45 people generously donated their talent and time** to Historic Geneva.

Fundraising

Despite the continued impact of the pandemic we managed to hold our own and we couldn’t (and can’t continue) to do so without the financial support from a variety of sources.

Donations, participation in the **online auctions and quilt raffle**, contributing to our **Support Campaigns**, and donating items to or shopping at our **Holiday Market** were just some of the ways the community showed their continued support.

Support for our operating costs and programming initiatives came through a combination of **publicly and privately funded grants**. We received grants from the following organizations City and Town of Geneva, ESL Charitable Foundation, Farash Foundation, Humanities New York, Nelson B. Delavan Foundation Part A, NYSCA, and Wyckoff Family Foundation.

Through Generations Bank we participated in the second round of the **Payroll Protection Program** and received full loan forgiveness.

We also relied on income from our **three endowments** (General Endowment, Rose Hill Endowment, and John A. Hutchins Memorial Fund).

Thank you to our supporters, grant funders, donors, and others who generously supported Historic Geneva in 2021.

Highlights from 2021

Rebranding to **Historic Geneva**.

We welcomed four **new trustees** to the Board and **new employees**, including Mel Oles as the Visitor Services and Programs Manager.

The **exhibits** at the Geneva History Museum were *An Educated Citizenry: Education in Geneva*, *My Geneva Is*, Geneva City School District Art Show, *Geneva Innovators*, *We Stayed At Home: A Record of Geneva in the Covid-19 Pandemic*, *My Geneva Is (Home Edition)*, and *Community Curators*.

The former Tasting Room at Rose Hill was renovated into a **vacation rental**, which will be managed by Finger Lakes Premier Properties.

As part of our rebrand, we had InHouse Design **refresh our website** and **add online ticketing** for Rose Hill and select events.

We continued to expand our digital outreach by producing **new video content** for YouTube and our website. In addition, all available **finding aids** were added to the Empire Archival Discovery Cooperative.

Special collection projects included **digitizing cassette tapes, slides, and church records**.

Partnering with organizations and participating in community events allowed us to reach to a broad audience. Our outreach activities included blog articles for *Edible Finger Lakes*; programs for Girl Scouts, Zonta Club, and Lyceum Heights; participating in the Farmer's Market and Rotary Club's Santa Time; creating the Geneva Heritage Trail; and contributing to New York Heritage's online exhibit *Immigration in New York State, 1650-1950*.
